Students may submit their applications after having looked through the partner universities by reviewing the academic programs and courses offered by the partner universities and by consulting their Erasmus Department Coordinators for the eligibility of programs regarding their own Department/Program at Altınbaş University.

Financial support cannot be provided for these exchanges. Regardless of the country/university difference, round-trip flight tickets* will be covered for the mobility of 3 students in the spring semester. * Considering the AU WORLD CHANGE success grade

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. All **full-time students enrolled** in a higher education program (associate, undergraduate, graduate, doctorate, medical specialty) offered by Altınbaş University are eligible to apply for student mobility.
- 2. Students are required to have a minimum GPA of **2.50 out of 4.00**.
- 3. To be eligible to participate in Erasmus learning mobility, applicants must have enough **ECTS credits/student workload.** Under the European Commission's ECTS Users' Guide, 60 ECTS credits are allocated to the learning outcomes and associated workload of a full-time academic year.

All students wishing to participate in Erasmus+ mobility for studies are free to apply to the program, yet, only students who meet the minimum requirements shall be eligible to sit the English Proficiency Test.

REQUIRED APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- 1. AU World Exchange Program Application Form (Application form must be signed by Erasmus Department/Programme/Vocational School Coordinator. When completing the application form, attention shall be paid to the compatibility of curriculum between partner institution and Altınbaş University, medium of instruction used by the partner institution, as well location and accommodation. You will also need to consider whether the academic calendar of your university matches the academic calendar of the partner institution when deciding on which semester you would like to do your International Exchange)
- 2. Transcript (showing the Fall Spring of the Academic Year when you submit your application)

After having collected the required documents, the applicant should submit documents to the application system. In case there are any **missing documents**, such applications shall not be approved.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

- Applicants should have at least a B2 level of the language that they will study at partner universities.
- Prep-school passing grade is valid for 2 years only for students who are studying only in English programs.



Students should take the **Foreign Language Placement Test** to be administered by Altınbaş University School of Foreign Languages on **11.03.2022** or submit a valid English language certificate issued by YDS, YÖKDİL, and TOEFL to the application system. Students are also responsible for keeping track of important announcements posted on the Altınbaş University website and delivered to their e-mail inboxes.

Other Languages: B2 level certificates issued by Cultural Centres operating under the Embassies of relevant countries by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

ASSESSMENT PROCESS

- AU World Exchange Score is calculated as follows: 50% of GPA + 50% of language test score. AU World
 Exchange score is an important factor when determining the partner University for Student Mobility.
 Students will be ranked by their AU World Exchange score based on undergraduate/
 graduate/vocational programs.
- When calculating Exchange Score, Students with disabilities will be added by 10 points to the overall score by applicant's status
- Minimum passing score for Language Test is 60.
 To participate in the AU World Exchange applicants must meet these requirements.
- Application process consists of 3 stages:
 - **1. Foreign Language Test Score**: Announcement of the Foreign Language Placement Test Results administered by the School of Foreign Languages.
 - **2. International Exchange Score**: International Exchange Score is calculated and announced following the assessment.
 - **3. Placement:** By their International Exchange Scores, students are placed in partner institutions by a commission.
- Students are required to receive acceptance letters from the host institution as well to participate in Erasmus mobility.
- While any procedure regarding going abroad, finding accommodation abroad, health insurance, passport, and visa procedures are principally the student's responsibility, Erasmus Office may provide support for Partner University and Altınbaş University.
- Within 5 working days before the placement of partner universities for students who have not submitted the opt-out form to the Erasmus Office, the next -10 points are deducted from the total score of the AU Exchange Program for applications.
- Students of the AU World Exchange Program are required to take at least 20 ECTS courses per semester at a partner university.
