SUNKEN CITY KEKOVA

Scenic Mediterranean island, famous for its magnificent beaches and mysterious sunken city



Kekova, also named Caravola, is a small Turkish island near Demre (Demre is the Lycian town of Myra) district of Antalya province which faces the villages of Kaleköy (ancient Simena) and Üçağız (ancient Teimioussa).

On its northern side there are the partly sunken ruins of Dolchiste/Dolikisthe, an ancient town which was destroyed by an earthquake during the 2nd century. Kekova was one the largest commercial area of the Mediterranean once a time, is described as an open-air museum with a tombs of the kings, natural harbor, church, bath, shipyards, theater and more.
