1. IMPORTANT NOTICE

- Although Azerbaijan does only have a couple of bilateral or multilateral visa-free agreements with other countries, the country offers an online visa system called “ASAN” that eliminates lengthy visa processes for more than 90 nationalities around the world.
- Those countries that are eligible for an online visa or a visa-free entry to Azerbaijan are listed on the next page.

* Countries that are eligible for a visa-free entry to Azerbaijan for 90 days within a 180 days period.

** Turkiye citizens are exempt from a visa to Azerbaijan for a duration of 30 days.

***United States nationals can also obtain a visa on arrival by traveling with a New York-Baku direct flight.

In addition to these, individuals who have a residence permit from Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, or Kuwait with an accompanying person of the country that issued the residence permit can both obtain a visa on arrival that is valid for 30 days in Azerbaijan.

Countries that are not listed on the previous page have to apply for a **visa through embassies** beforehand to visit Azerbaijan.

2. D-TYPE LONG TERM VISA

- ❑ Azerbaijan category D visas are required for stays that exceed a three month period with varying purposes in Azerbaijan even if the applicant's nationality is on the visa-free list. It is possible for you to apply for a long-term visa to Azerbaijan if you are a student planning to study at a higher education institution, have a language course, or long-term internship.
- ❑ You are required to present the following documents if your nationality is not eligible for a visa-free entry or an online visa to Azerbaijan:
 - Photocopy of passport and ID section (Passports must be valid for at least 3 more months from the date of travel and must have at least 2 blank pages.)
 - 2 biometric photographs (Photos must be in 3X4 dimensions and in front of a white background.)
 - Azerbaijan visa application form
 - Copy of identity card
 - Proof of birth certificate
 - Invitation letter
 - Confirmed round-trip airfare and hotel reservation
 - Bank account statement (stamped and wet signed)
 - Proof of payment of the fee
 - Petition containing travel purpose, duration and financial information
 - Travel health insurance policy
 - SSI service breakdown and payroll (valid for insured employees)
 - Activity certificate and circular of signature (valid for employers)
 - Vehicle license, title deeds and credit card information, if any

Additional Documents:

Students:

- A copy of a recent letter confirming the enrollment of the applicant in the country of citizenship.
- Sponsorship documents if the applicant cannot support himself/herself financially during the period of the stay

Employed:

- Employment contract
- A letter from the company that states your absence, duration of the stay, and confirms returning to current job
- Bank statement of the last six months

3. VISA RULES



- The passport should be valid for more than three months from the expected day of arrival to Azerbaijan.
- A notarized copy of a birth certificate and documented permission of both parents, as well as copy of their ID, should be included for underaged travelers.
- The electronic visa should be printed and presented together with a passport at a border checkpoint.
- Foreign citizens who have visited the disputed Nagorno-Karabakh area after 1991 **cannot enter** Azerbaijan.

! Gulf Cooperation Council nationals (Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, and Saudi Arabia) can be granted a **single-entry electronic visa** to Azerbaijan at the international airports.

!!**Armenia citizens** and citizens of any other country from Armenian descent **are banned** from entering Azerbaijan; excluding certain circumstances that needs special permissions.
