1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Morocco has many bilateral or multilateral agreements with many countries around the world that eliminate visa requirements, and those nationals can enter Morocco without a visa.
- It is critical that the forms provided at the country's entry and exit points are correctly and completely filled out. The importation or removal of undeclared foreign currency worth 100,000 Dirhams (approximately 9,000 Euros) or more into Morocco is prohibited. Every day of the week, there are reciprocal airline flights between Istanbul and Casablanca.
- The next page lists the countries that are eligible for visa-free entry into Morocco for 90 days in a 180-day period.

Countries that are not listed above have to apply for a visa beforehand to visit Morocco through its embassies or consular post.

D Type (Long-Term) Visa Morocco Category D visas are required for stays in Morocco that exceed three months for a variety of reasons, even if the applicant's nationality is on the visa-free list.

If you are one of the following, you may apply for a long-term visa to Morocco:

- A student who intends to attend a higher education institution, take a language course, or work on a long-term internship
- An employee who is going to work for a company in Morocco
- An academic, researcher, or scientist to work in a Morocco research center that has been certified
- A person whose family member is a Morocco citizen
- A patient undergoing medical treatment in a Moroccan medical facility



2. VISA RULES

- Your passport should be valid for **more than six months** from the expected day of arrival to Morocco with at **least one blank page available** for stamping.
- The passport **should not be** older than ten years.



3. GENERAL VISA APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

If your nationality does not qualify for a visa-free entry or an online visa to Morocco, you must present the following documents:

- Completed visa application form
- Original and two photocopies of the passport
- two passport-sized photographs
- A round-trip flight ticket
- Proof of lodging and sufficient financial resources are required for the duration of your stay.
- Travel insurance
- Receipt of Morocco visa fee
- Certain applicants must also submit the following documents as additional documentation:

Students:

- Acopy of a recent letter confirming the applicant's enrollment in the country of citizenship
- Sponsorship documents are required if the applicant is unable to support himself/herself financially during the duration of the stay.

Employed:

- A letter of employment from the employer
- Payroll receipts for the previous three months
