

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Do I Need a Visa To Go To Taiwan?

Turkish citizens must obtain a visa to enter Taiwan. Turkiye is one of the nations whose citizens can apply for an E-visa. Taiwan visa is an electronic travel authorization document for Turkish people. This document is available for download and application online. This document does not require a trip to the embassy.

Those who are simply transiting through Turkiye and have not entered the country do not need to apply for a transit visa.

Philippine nationals are eligible to visit Taiwan visa-free for 14 days.

<u>Important Note:</u> Visas are not required for some countries to visit Taiwan for 15, 30, or 90 days. To see those countries please <u>click here.</u>



2. STAY VISA FOR TOURISM

To apply for a stay visa to visit the country, the applicant must submit all relevant documents and visa payments to the embassy. Also, the applicant can apply this visa online. If an interview is required, Taiwan abroad missions will contact the applicant.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Form for requesting a visa. Fill out the "*Online Application Form*," print out the barcoded visa application form, and sign in person for confirmation
- 2. Two 2-inch color photos within 6 months. The background must be white
- 3. Original Passport and it's photocopy. Passport should be valid for more than 6 months and must have blank pages
- 4. Evidence of financial resources (e.g. bank statement)
- 5. Itinerary



- 6. Round-trip airfare. Airline ticket, electronic ticket, or travel agency certificate
- 7. Other documents if it is required

3. VISA FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

Students who wish to study in Taiwan (Exchange Students) must obtain a visa for foreign students. Visa is valid for six months. To get more information and see if there are any other requirements, please contact your consulate.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Visa application form
- 2. Two 2-inch color photos within 6 months. The background must be white
- 3. Passport photocopy and original. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months and contain blank pages. Please photocopy the passport's basic information page, including the photograph
- 4. The original and photocopy of the approval letter from the college or university or the approval letter from the competent educational administration at all levels



- 5. Enrollment Permit/School of Study Notification. Exchange students must produce the admission permit or admission letter issued by the school they are attending for verification
- 6. The original and a photocopy of the certificate of foreign education. Verification of enrolment or student ID issued by the originating institution overseas, or proof of exchange consent
- 7. Additional documents needed for the case. It is dependent on the requirements of the individual case evaluation (for example: certificate of purpose of coming to Taiwan, parental consent letter, guarantee letter of relatives in Taiwan, consent letter of guardian in Taiwan, certificate of no criminal record, educational cooperation signed by the exchange school or proof of sister school agreement etc.)



4. VISA FOR GENERAL SOCIAL VISITS

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Visa application form
- 2. Two 2-inch color photos within 6 months. The background must be white
- 3. Passport original and photocopy. Valid for more than 6 months and must have blank pages
- 4. Invitation letter. Issued by the inviting unit
- 5. Proof of financial resources (e.g. bank statement)
- 6. Itinerary
- 7. Other documents as required by the case. Such as plane tickets, e-tickets, travel agency certificates

6. E-VISA


- The E-visa is an official document issued by the Taiwan's Foreign Embassies that allows foreigners to enter Taiwan and travel inside the nation. Another new option to replace the issuance of paper visas by Taiwan Diplomatic Offices abroad is the E-visa. Applicants will receive an E-visa after providing the required basic personal information, paying by card (MasterCard or Visa), and having their eligibility checked.
- E-visa is available to apply on 19 countries: Bahrain, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Burkina Faso, Colombia, Dominica, Ecuador, Kiribati, Kosovo, Kuwait, Mauritius, Montenegro, Oman, Panama, Peru, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Solomon Islands, Turkiye and United Arab Emirates.
- There are some regulations about the people who wants to apply E-visa if those invited to participate in international conferences, events or trade exhibitions hosted, co-organized or sponsored by central government agencies. To see them, please *click here*.



- The E-visa is valid for three months from the date of issue, with a single entry and a maximum stay in Taiwan for 30 days, which cannot be extended.
- The E-visa application fee is NT\$1,600. However, together with the bank charge of NT\$46 paid by credit card, the total is NT\$1,646. The countries exempt from the visa fee are Bosnia and Herzegovina, Colombia, Kiribati, Kosovo, Mauritius, Montenegro, Panama, Peru, Solomon Islands, Turkiye.


