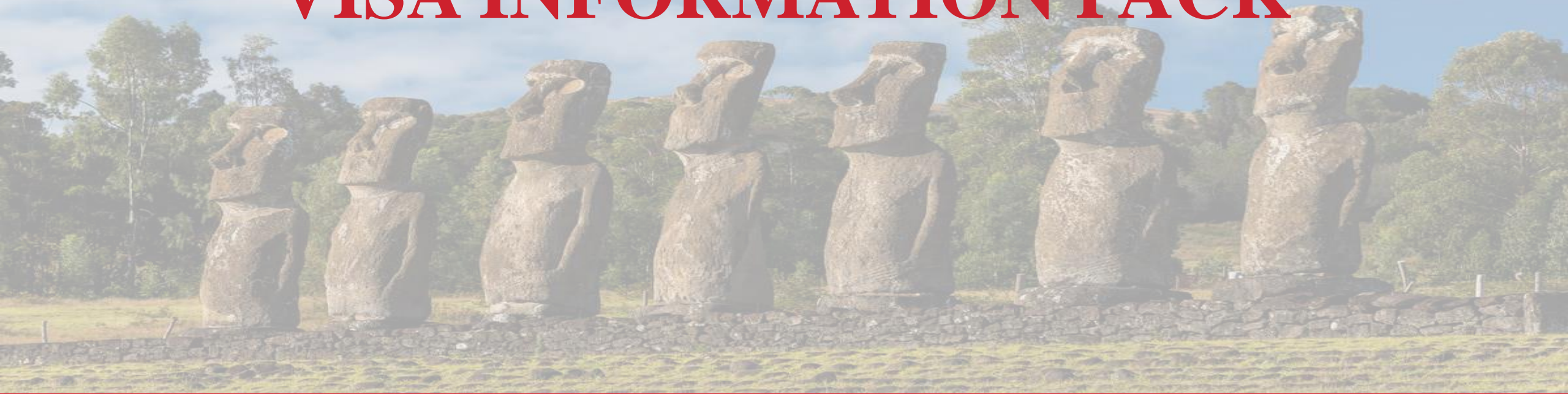

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Do I need a visa to go to Chile?

Turkish citizens holding official and ordinary passports are *exempt from visa up to 90 days* .

If you are not a Turkish citizen, please contact with the local consulate or embassy to get information.

Types of Stay in Chile:

- To be in Chile for *less than 90 days (transitory stay)*, you must apply through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- For periods of *more than 90 days (temporary or permanent residence)*, who processes the requests is the National Migration Service (under the Ministry of the Interior) and the Consulates around the world.

2. TRANSITORY STAY (Transitory Permanence)

- Transitory Permanence is the permit granted by the border control authority or by the Chilean consulate abroad, to foreigners who enter Chile with no intention of settling in the country, which authorizes them to remain in national territory for a limited period. .
- This permit authorizes them to remain in the national territory *for a maximum limited period of 90 days, which can be extended for a further 90 days only once.*
- The validity of the Transitory Permanence permit may not exceed the validity time of the passport or travel document.

People who enter for tourist, recreational, business, or other similar purposes (Sub-category 1):

This sub-category of Transitory Permanence is aimed at foreigners who enter Chile for recreational, sports, health, study, business management, family or other similar purposes, such as members and staff of public shows, athletes, lecturers, advisors and expert technicians, among others.

Turkiye do not have to obtain transitory permanence for up to ***90 days***.

3. TEMPORARY STAY (Permanent Residence)

- *For stays of more than 90 days*, a residence permit (temporary or permanent) must be requested.
- Temporary Residence is the permit granted by the National Migration Service (SERMIG) to foreigners who intend to settle in Chile for a limited time , which will be valid for *up to 2 years*, except for the subcategory of seasonal workers.
- Transitory permanence have sub-categories dependent on the reason of application. Those sub-categories may have different required documents and process. To see all sub-categories and take information, please [click here](#).

Temporary Residence For Students (Sub-Category 3)

It is a Temporary Residence permit from the National Migration Service (SERMIG) that can be requested by foreigners who are interested in settling in Chile for the purpose of studying in educational establishments recognized by the State , complying with the corresponding requirements.

Documentation required to apply for temporary residence as a student:

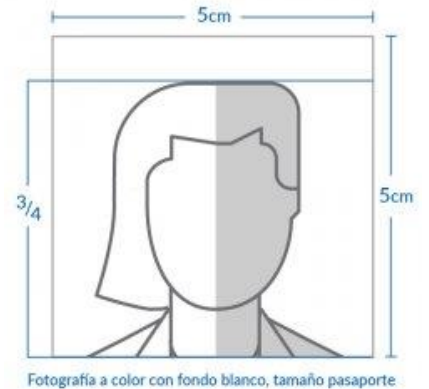
1. Passport or identification document
2. Criminal record certificate or equivalent document issued by the competent authority of their country of origin or the one in which they have resided in the last 5 years (of legal age)
3. Regular student certificate or enrollment certificate
4. Accredited financial support, through: Bank deposits; Periodic transfers to your name; Sworn declaration of expenses of your maintainer in Chile signed before a notary, who must prove income; among others. If you have a Scholarship, present the Scholarship Certificate, indicating the period of duration, funding and study center

Important Note: Additional documents may be requested, and a personal interview may be required, which must be attended by presenting all original documentation.

GENERAL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR TEMPORARY STAY PERMIT:

1. Complete the form and explain the reason for the trip and length of stay.
2. Upload a photograph: color with a white background, passport size (5x5 cm), full face.
3. Copy of the current passport personalization sheet.
4. Hotel/lodging reservation that can be verified or letter of invitation signed before a Chilean Notary, contact number of the inviter.
5. Evidence of residence (immigration status) in case of residing in a country other than that of their nationality. You must indicate the reason and the stamp of entry to the country.
6. Evidence of own economic income (last three salary statements and/or bills with bank movement).
7. Criminal record certificate from the country of origin or country of residence (minimum residence of 2 years), apostilled, valid for 60 days.
8. Not having a prohibition to enter Chile, in accordance with current immigration regulations.
