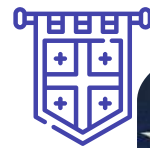

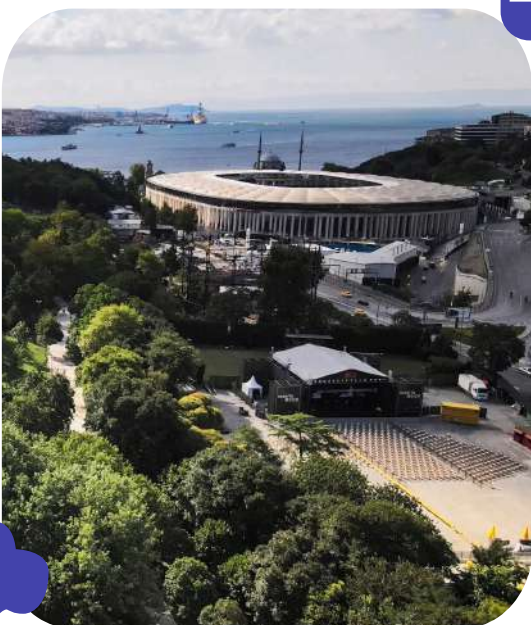

MAÇKA PARK

Cozy leisure park with walking paths and interesting history.

Maçka Democracy Park is a recreational area in Istanbul, which has paths for jogging, walking and dog walking. It also has rest areas and benches and decorative pools. The area was part of the Dolmabahçe Palace's gardens and was separated from the gardens being used as a parkland in the mid-19th century. It had been named as Maçka Park referring to people from the Black Sea region who were sent to Constantinople shortly after the conquest of the region by Mehmed II in 1461. There is also a gondola line in the park. The gondola line was constructed to provide easy access between Maçka and Taşkılla, two localities in the center of the city separated from each other by a 42 m deep green valley.

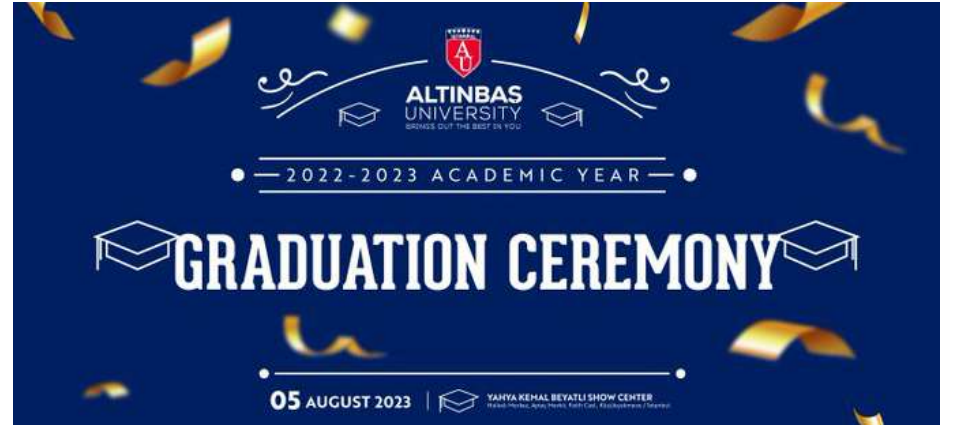
