1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Do I need a visa to travel Nepal?

- Turkish citizens holding diplomatic, service, special and ordinary passport are subject to a visa.
- Turkish citizens can apply for a visa on arrival when travelling to Nepal. The visa is issued at the entry point of the country.

<u>Important Note:</u> If you are not applying from Turkiye, please contact with the nearest consulate to get information. <u>Click here</u> to see all embassies around the world.

<u>Important Note:</u> Turkiye do not have any diplomatic missions or consulate of Nepal. *But Embassy of Nepal in Islamabad is accredited to Turkiye*. To get information, please contact with the embassy in Islamabad.

3. VISA ON ARRIVAL (TOURIST VISA)

On Arrival Visas are "Tourist Visas". They bear multiple-entry facility. Tourist Visa 'On Arrival' is the only entry visa to Nepal. If you are visiting Nepal for the purposes other than Tourism (sightseeing, tour, travel, mountaineering, trekking, visiting friends and families), you should still get tourist visa to get into the country. However, you must change the category of visa as per your purpose and length of stay in Nepal from Department of Immigration by producing required documents.

Once you arrive at the airport, please follow these simple procedures for Tourist Visa on Arrival.

1st Step

- Fill in "Arrival Card "
- *Fill in Online Tourist Visa*. If you fill it from the website, you will get submission receipt with barcode, please print it out and bring it along for acquiring visa. It works for fifteen days and becomes invalid then after. If so, you will have to fill it up again.

2nd Step

- Make payment at the bank according to your visa requirement
- Get the receipt

3rd Step

- Proceed to the Immigration Desk with your online form, payment receipts and your passport
- Hand in your documents to immigration officer for visa processing

4. STUDY VISA

Study visa is issued to foreign students pursuing academic /non-academic degree and research in Nepal.

It is issued by the Department of Immigration upon the recommendation of Ministry of Education. It is also issued to teachers/professors involved in academic work (teaching) in Nepal upon recommendations from the concerned agencies of Nepal Government. It is issued for *maximum of one year* as per the recommendation or length of study.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- 1. Recommendation letter from Ministry of Education
- 2. University /College Admission Receipt (original)



- Bank Statement (latest one week) with sufficient funds.
- Online Application form
- Copies of passport
- Marriage Certificate and Birth Certificate (for those applying their spouse and children as dependents)
- 7. Progress report Card (for renewal of Student Visa)
- For Researcher applying for student visa, following additional documents should also be produced;
 - Offer/Appointment letter from Academic Institution of Nepal
 - General Agreement between two Academic Institutions

STUDY VISA FEE	
Single Re-entry Facility	20 USD
Multiple Re-entry Facility	60 USD



5. TRANSIT VISA



- Foreign nationals having a transit in Nepal can obtain Transit Visa to enter the country to spend a night (24 hours) by producing a *proof of transit* (*Air ticket*). Similarly, the foreign nationals arriving to Nepal due to untoward circumstances such as emergency or forced landing can acquire tourist visa if they want to leave the airport and visit the country.
- Transit Visa applicants should fill out <u>Online Visa Application</u>, pay necessary *Visa fee (5 USD)* at the bank counter and proceed to Transit Visa desk after arriving at the airport for acquiring the Visa. Transit Visa is issued by Immigration Officer.


