### 1. GENERAL VISA PROCEDURES IN ALBANIA

Albania does not require a visa for citizens of the Republic of Turkey traveling for 90 days within 180 days. This also applies to 48 additional countries.\*

- Those seeking an Albania visa should schedule an appointment with the nearest honorary consulate, consulate general, or embassy. All necessary documents must be brought to the appointment.
- Albania requires all foreign citizens who will obtain a residence permit or stay in the country for more than 90 days to obtain a Type D (Long Term) Visa.
- A Type D visa must be applied for at least one month before the trip.
- Applications can be made directly to embassies or consulates, or through authorized agencies that provide consultancy services.
- The passport must be valid for at least three months after the D type visa expires.



# 2. WHAT DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR A D-TYPE VISA APPLICATION?

- Passport (2 pages must be blank for Albania visa)
- Photocopy of passport and visas
- 2 biometric photographs (35x45 mm, white background, taken within the last 6 months)
- Visa application form
- Receipt of Visa Fees
- Travel health insurance
- Letter of consent (notarized permission document by parents for those under 18 years old)

- Criminal record
- Police report
- Invitation letter from Albania
- Documents proving and confirming that all living expenses and tuition fees will be covered
  Accommodation documents
- Documents proving knowledge of Albanian



## 3. E-VISA APPLICATION SYSTEM



- Albania E-visa system is a system created to make visa applications easier and safer.
- It is open to all countries.


